**Re:** **Clinical Learning Guidelines during the COVID-19 Pandemic**

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Dear Faculty,

All 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year undergraduate medical learners training in our Horizon Health facilities follow Horizon Health guidelines for care of patients with COVID-19. In addition, the Universities may add restrictions for their learners. Please see the following recommendations below:



All 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year **Dalhousie** medical students in New Brunswick will be permitted to participate in all clinical activities, including those involving aerosol-generating medical procedures (AGMP) and those requiring N95 masks. Dalhousie students can care for COVID-19 patients and should follow all Infection Control protocols regarding appropriate use of PPE for all clinical situations.



All 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year **Memorial** medical learners are permitted to participate in direct care of all patients without confirmed COVID-19 and those requiring AGMP where only standard precautions are required. Learners must be excluded from direct care where patient status is COVID-19 positive or where N-95 mask is required for high risk AGMP.

COVID-19 status unknown does not preclude the learner from direct patient care.
